Waterfront Park Amphitheater Docks Rules and Regulations

- No parking is permitted on park sidewalks, ramps, or lawn areas, or any other areas that are not specifically designated parking spaces.
- Lessee must keep the Docks and surrounding properties free from trash. Trash receptacles will be provided in areas designated by Lessor.
- No chairs, tables, coolers, garbage, dock boxes, or other obstructions are permitted on the Docks or surrounding areas.
- Dinghies or other small service boats are to be placed on the owner's vessel. Docks are to be left clear of all objects and debris.
- The use of City provided water and electricity must be kept to a minimum.
- The speed of boats in the marinas shall not exceed 6 M.P.H. and with no wake.
- Boats must be docked in such a manner as to prevent propellers from coming in contact with floats.
- Owners are responsible for damage done by their boats to docks, floats, moorings and other boats.
- Pets should be leashed when on docks and should not be left unattended when on vessels.
- Pouring of gasoline is NOT PERMITTED on any boat or dock in the marina.
- Landing floats are to be used only for loading gear or passenger, and such use must not exceed 15 minutes; this includes the West Beach launching ramp.
- All boat owners are responsible for maintaining, securing and bailing out their boats at ALL times. Owners are responsible for raising their vessels within 24 hours or when the vessel presents an imminent danger. WDC reserves the right to take any and all corrective actions to ensure the safety of all docks and boats at the owner's expense plus a \$100.00 administrative fine. No liability will be assumed by WDC should it be required to take this action.
- To avoid pedestrian accidents, loose hoses and mooring lines on the dock are prohibited.
- Electrical outlet is included with slip fees. Cables must be unplugged from the outlet box when your boat leaves the slip. Cables may not be strung across the docks for additional service. Only marine-approved cables may be used.
- Spray painting and power sanding is strictly prohibited in the marina. Brush painting is permissible as long as the dock, pilings and your neighbor's boat is protected. Disposal of paint and/or varnish in marina trash receptacles is strictly prohibited.
- Gas type portable cooking equipment is prohibited except in specifically authorized areas that are not on docks, finger piers, on boats or near flammables. They are not permitted on any wooden docks. Free standing grills are not permitted on your vessel.
- Pets must be kept on a leash which is to be attached to its human. DO NOT ALLOW PET TO CARRY ITS OWN LEASH. Leashes must be limited to 6' in length. Retractable leashes may be lengthened in the dog walk areas.
- Pets must remain in the owner's control at all times. Pet owners are responsible for cleaning up pet waste in the dog walk area. Should an accident occur elsewhere, it should be cleaned up immediately. Pets should never be left unattended on boats, in vehicles or tied up on the marina premises. Pets are not permitted in any marina building. If more than three (3) valid complaints are received for any pet, the pet will be banned from the marina.
- BOAT RELATED DISTURBANCES Tying down potential noisemakers, such as halyards, etc. will prevent noisy rattling in the wind.
- MUSIC Consider your neighbors and keep music volume down. Radios and stereos must be turned off by 11 pm. Dock parties must also be concluded by 11 pm.

- QUIET TIME Boater curfew is 11:00 p.m. be especially quiet during late night and early morning hours when your neighbors may be trying to sleep.
- FIREWORKS All fireworks, including sparklers, are prohibited in the marina.
